



Hall Mead School is an 11 – 16 co-educational Academy with a planned admission number to **Year 7 in September 2025 of 210.**

ACADEMY’S ADMISSION CRITERIA

When the demand exceeds the number of places available in Hall Mead, places are allocated by applying the following criteria in descending order of priority to applicants who have expressed any preference for the school.

- 1) Looked after Children and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a residence order or special guardianship order).
- 2) The attendance in September 2024 at Hall Mead of an older brother or sister.
- 3) The distance of the home address from Hall Mead, as measured in a straight line from the school, those living nearer the school being given higher priority.

EXPRESSION OF PREFERENCES

In all years a small number of places became available to be reallocated. It was, therefore, possible to satisfy further preferences.
